



A) JOB PURPOSE

- Provide technical input during detailed engineering of projects.
- Provide support and input into the preparation of PED technical files.
- Provide support and input into the preparation of construction workpacks and certification documentation.
- Responsible for technical decision making associated with any given scope of work.
- Establish good working relationships and communication with discipline leads, department managers and clients.
- Contribute to the development of engineering staff
